The use of **ozone** for the valorization of **agroresources and lignocellulosic fibers** is developing throughout the world. There is a real **need to connect researchers and manufacturers** and to accompany new applications **from research to industrial level**.

We invite you to the first **Ozone Days** that will be held on **March 23-24, 2022, at the UniLaSalle Campus** (Beauvais, France).

The main purpose of this seminar is to present the state of development of ozone in **pulp bleaching** and in **food processing**. The future domains of application in **pulping and biorefinery** will be also introduced.
